INVITES RESEARCH PROPOSALS UNDER EMR SCHEME

Directorate of Forensic Science Services under Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India has implemented the Extra Mural Research (EMR) Programme through which financial support is provided to eligible investigators/ institutions for carrying out research activities related to emerging areas of Forensic Science. For the year 2021-22, the priority areas of research studies and projects are:

- 1. Damaged Media Analysis
- 2. Automatic approach for facial recognition
- 3. Sequence of Strokes and determination of manipulations in the digital documents
- 4. Personal behavioral characteristics and psycho-linguistics characteristics for personal identification
- 5. Development of software for DNA database
- 6. Development of X-STR/Y-STR/Autosomal Kits indigenously
- 7. Development of software for recovery of overwritten /deleted files from CCTV/DVR/Hard Disk.
- 8. Reconstruction of corrupt /bad sector video files retrieved from CCTV/DVR
- 9. Computerized approach for decrypting data from encrypted disk partition
- 10. Recovery of previous user data from factory reset phones and formatted flash memory
- 11. Decryption of whatsApp database files retrieved from phone memory
- 12. Development of software for authentication of audio-video footage
- 13. Enhancement of CCTV Footage and recognition of person through computer approach(Facial Recognition)
- 14. Automatic identification of signatures/handwriting
- 15. Computerized technique for identification of fired ammunition with respect to Fire Arms and creation of database
- 16. Development of device for collection and detection of fumes and vapors produced by inflammable substances
- 17. Any other project of emerging forensic interest

Accordingly, applications are invited from eligible investigators/institutions in prescribed format for consideration of project proposals for support during the year 2021-22.
