The Central theme of the Conference will be, "**Emerging Trends in Personal Identification in Forensic science**". Confirmed dates and venue will be informed in due course of time. The programme will include Invited talks/lectures on forensic related key issues and technical sessions for oral and poster presentation on research work, case examination/ findings. In view of this, scientific papers are invited from the forensic community, for presentation during the Conference.

2. Full papers will only be accepted for the ensuing conference. **The last date for receipt of Full paper with abstract is June 7, 2019. No request will be entertained after the last date.** Please send abstract and full paper by post (in hard and CD form) or by email 25thcifsc@gmail.com on or before June 7, 2019 to enable us to process, evaluate and select to include in the proceedings, if accepted. Please mention clearly on the Envelop/Paper the discipline of the paper. **This OM may please be circulated widely in the RFSLs/DMFUs of your state.**

3. After acceptance/selection of the papers, full papers will be required for presentation in the conference on the main disciplines/inter-disciplines related to forensic science which are briefly given as under:-


1. Forensic Biological sciences (Oral & Poster presentation)
2. Forensic Chemical sciences (Oral & Poster presentation)
3. Forensic Physical sciences (Oral & Poster presentation)
4. Forensic Document Sciences (Oral & Poster Presentation)
5. Cyber/Computer Forensics (Oral & Poster)
6. Forensic Psychology (Oral & Poster)
7. Crime Scene Management (including Best Photograph of the crime scene (Oral & Poster presentation)

4. The best paper/ presentation in each discipline will be given an award. For the selection of best photograph of the scene of crime, the photograph should be in natural colour printed in A3 size paper, depicting scientifically significant aspects of the particular crime scene findings with most suited caption. Instructions for authors are also enclosed as Annexure 'A'. Please read instructions carefully before submission of papers.

8. The Conference is scheduled for 2 days for presentation of scientific papers, invited talks and other scientific presentations. All India Forensic Science Conference is an event to encourage authors to send their papers for presentation in different disciplines of forensic science: Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Scene of Crime, etc. The papers for presentation in the conference should be sent to the address given below with a caption "**RESEARCH PAPER FOR PRESENTATION IN 25TH ALL INDIA FORENSIC SCIENCE CONFERENCE**":

Papers will only be accepted for presentation on the condition that the contents have not been published or submitted for publication or for presentation elsewhere and are subject to editing and editorial change required for conformity with the proceedings of the conference. In case of case study presentation including papers related to Scene of crime management, Best Photograph of a crime scene and Best crime case investigation by Police IO, it should be of recent period and the Director, FSL/SP of the concerned area must certify the same. The author(s) have to give the following undertaking while submitting the abstract.

"The paper entitled,....." submitted for presentation during the 25th All India Forensic Science Conference has not been published /sent for publication or presentation in any other journal/conference and it is the original work of the author(s) concerned."

Manuscripts : Two high quality copies on white A-4 size paper along with the CD containing the contents of the paper should be submitted.

- ◇ The title should be brief and to the point. The names of the author(s) should appear on the title page only with their affiliations and full address.
- ◇ The abstract should be brief and to the point, factual and not normally more than 100 words.
- ◇ Authors should take care to ensure accuracy of the data and references should be cited from the original publications.

IMPORTANT:

1. **DISCIPLINE (INTER DISCIPLINE)/ NAME OF THE AUTHOR/TITLE OF THE PAPER MUST BE MENTIONED ON THE ENVELOP/CD AND ON THE PAPER**
2. NAME OF THE HEAD OF THE CFSL/SFSL/ANY OTHER FORENSIC INSTITUTION, CONTACT ADDRESS, EMAIL ID, FAX NUMBER, MOBILE NUMBER(S) OF THE AUTHOR IS REQUIRED TO BE CLEARLY MENTIONED ON THE TOP OF THE PAPER.
3. ONLY THE MAIN AUTHOR OF THE SELECTED PAPER WILL BE ALLOWED TO ATTEND THE CONFERENCE
