NOTIFICATION

G.S.R.- In exercise of powers conferred by provision to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following Rules regulating the methods of recruitment to the post of Deputy director(Forensic Science), Group 'A' post, in the Ministry of Home Affairs, Directorate of Forensic Science Services, namely :-

1. Short title and commencement.-

- (i) These rules may be called the Ministry of Home Affairs, Directorate of Forensic Science Services, Deputy Director (Forensic Science), Group 'A' post, Recruitment Rules, 2019.
- (ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number, classification and Level in the Pay Matrix:-

The number of the posts, their classification and Level in the Pay Matrix- attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the said schedule.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualification etc:-

The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in columns 5 to 13 of the aforesaid schedule.

4. Disqualification:- No person –

- (i) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
- (ii) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts.

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of these rules.

5. Power to relax:-

Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving:-

Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

(ii) 15 Years' experience of analytical methods and research therein, out of which at least 8 years' experience should be in the Forensic Science Laboratory.

Note 1.- Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other Organization/ department of the Central/State Government shall ordinarily not to exceed 4 years.

The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation (including short term contract) shall be, not exceeding 56 years, as on the closing date of receipts of applications).

Note 2.- The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.
