2. In case no comments are received from the stakeholders a NIL report may please be submitted to this directorate.



G.S.R. .. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Bureau of Police Research and Development (Group B Posts) Recruitment Rules, 1994, in so far as it relate to the post of Stenographer Grade II, except as respects things done or omitted to have been done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Stenographer Grade I in the Directorate of Forensic Science Services, Ministry of Home Affairs, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement. - (1) These rules may be called the Directorate of Forensic Science Services, Stenographer Grade I (Group B post) Recruitment Rules, 2018.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of posts, classification and Level in the Pay Matrix. - The number of posts, its classification and Level in the Pay Matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualification etc. - The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matter connected therewith shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification. - No person, -

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

(b) who having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person;

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax. - where the Central government is of opinion that it is necessary to expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing in consultation with Union Public Service commission relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category or persons.

6. Saving. - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-Servicemen and other special

categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Dopt Remaks :

The words - in consultation with Union Public Service Commission - are to be added in Rule -5 between the word writing and relax in the second line.

Stenographers Grade-II in the Level 4 of the Pay Matrix with Ten Years regular service in the grade / Level.

Deputation:

Officers Holding the post of stenographer under the Central Government

(a) (i) Holding analogous post on regular basis in the parent cadre or department;

or

(ii) with ten years regular service in the level 4 in the pay matrix or equivalent.

Standard Notes:

Where juniors who have completed their qualifying/eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their senior would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying / eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying /eligibility service or 2 years, whichever is less and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade along with their juniors who have already completed such qualifying/eligibility service

The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, the deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

The period of deputation including the period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization/department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years. The Maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall be Not exceeding 56 years as on the last date of receipt of applications
