NOTIFICATION

G.S.R. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Assistant Central Intelligence Officer Grade I (Document Photographer) in the Bureau of Police Research and Development, Ministry of Home Affairs, namely :-

1. Short title and commencement :- These rules may be called the Bureau of Police Research and Development Assistant Central Intelligence Officer Grade I (Document Photographer) Recruitment Rules, 1990.

They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette.

2. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay :-

The number of the said post, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule hereto annexed.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualification etc. :-

The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in the columns 5 to 14 of the Schedule aforesaid.

4. Disqualification :- No person,

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such persons and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax :- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving :- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
